# Turkey Hunters Clinic at Jeffco

Turkey season is coming soon and both beginning and experienced hunters will want to brush up on their skills. Jefferson College is offering a Turkey Hunting Clinic for just that purpose on Thursday, April 16.

Ray Eye, two-time Missouri champion turkey caller, will be featured speaker on the program which is scheduled for 7-9:30 p.m. in Lecture Hall 3 of the Arts and Sciences Building on the College's campus near Hillsboro. Eye has placed in more than 40 turkey calling contests since 1975. He is currently the Missouri Owl National Owl Hooting Championship sponsored by the National Wild Turkey

Championship sponsored by

the national Wild Turkey Foundation in New York.

Eye is unique in that he uses his voice to call turkeys with purrs, gobbles, chucks and yelps. He is also proficient in the use of various types of callers and he produces his own line of "Ozark Mountain Calls."

Eye has been calling and hunting turkeys for 12 years, including seven years spent as a guide. He has taken wild turkeys with bow, black powder and modern gun.
