



HILLSBORO, DEAD EYE — RAY EYE, RT. 1, HILLSBORO proudly displays a 20 lb. gobbler taken about 7 a.m. Tuesday, October 7 on Janes Creek at the foot Johnson Mountain south of Belgrade. Eye used only his voice to call the bird. The kill is possibly the first recorded in the state in the first archery turkey season ever held. The arrow went completely through the bird at about 20 feet and he ran with Eye in pursuit. The second shot stopped the bird but he still had to be hit in the head. Ray says the hunt was quite an experience and he verifies that turkeys are difficult to take with a bow and arrow.
